# What to Consider if You're Thinking About Plastic Surgery Abroad Overview:

Undergoing plastic surgery abroad can be a safe and affordable option—but only with the right preparation. This guide walks you through everything you should know before choosing a clinic or traveling internationally for a cosmetic procedure.

#### 1. Research Clinics & Surgeons Thoroughly

- Look for board-certified plastic surgeons—check with local medical boards and international organizations.
- Ask for before/after galleries, patient testimonials, and live consultations via video call.
- Confirm the type of anesthesia used and whether an anesthesiologist will be present.

### 2. Accreditation & Facility Standards

- Choose facilities accredited by Joint Commission International (JCI) or COFEPRIS (Mexico) / Costa Rica's Ministry of Health.
- Ensure sterile surgical environments and emergency protocols are in place.

#### 3. Know the Full Cost (and Hidden Fees)

- Include consultation, surgery, medication, anesthesia, recovery lodging, and follow-ups **Complications should they occur.**
- Ask about revision policies or additional procedures in case of complications.

## 4. Plan for Realistic Recovery Time

- Some surgeries require 10–21 days of local recovery before flying home.
- Avoid booking travel that is too close to your procedure.

#### 5. Use a Patient Advocate

• They help you avoid pitfalls, provide translation, arrange logistics, and vet providers.

Especially valuable if you need emergency care or revisions later.
